QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE*:

- 1) Eligible for Veterans Administration Health Benefits -OR- Served in the Reserve/National Guard called to active service under federal orders with tour of duty completed. AND/OR- Served at least 1 day of active duty with any discharge other than Dishonorable
- 2) Proof of military service: VA ID, DD-214, HINQs or Statement of Service.
- 3) Income equals 0 50% of the Area Median Income for household size.
- 4) Currently homeless or facing risk of homelessness.

The Volunteers of America Veteran Services Program provides advocacy, and case management including but not limited to:

- Housing Search
- Connection to Community Resources
- VA and Public Benefit connection
- Health, Mental Health, Dental Care Referrals
- Budgeting / Credit Counseling
- Employment Search

The Volunteers of America Veteran Services Program provides temporary financial assistance including but not limited to:

- Monthly local bus passes
- Rental application fees
- Security deposits and rental assistance
- Utility deposits and utility help
- Clothes, shoes, tools and licenses/certifications for employment
- Emergency supplies
