Delta, Colorado, June 3, 2020 – Delta County Daily Update

UPDATED Testing Information: Delta County Health Department is reporting one new case; our total case count is now 73 with 66 individuals now recovered.

- #70 - Female, in her 60s, currently hospitalized
- #71 - Female, in her 70s, self-isolating at home
- #72 - Female, in her 30s, self-isolating at home
- #73 - Male, in his 40s, self-isolating at home

44 individuals have tested positive; 29 individuals have been in close contact with an individual who tested positive, and have experienced COVID-19 symptoms, and one death is being reported.

To date, 1,246 tests have been administered in Delta County; 72 tests are pending.

Delta County Update

Delta County's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) has been downsized, and has moved out of a central location. EOC calls have moved to one weekly call, with Unified Command continuing to coordinate all EOC efforts on a daily basis. Additionally, the Joint Information Center is moving the daily update press release to Monday, Wednesday, and Friday only; reported case count information may lag behind state reporting for this reason.

State Update

Governor Polis recently signed an updated Safer at Home and in the Vast, Great Outdoors Executive order, which transitions from his Safer at Home Executive Order. You can find that order [here](#).

Previously, high-risk Coloradans, those above 65 or with underlying health conditions, were required to stay home unless absolutely necessary. With this Executive Order, those individuals are now encouraged to also enjoy Colorado's outdoor spaces at a safe social distance, in addition to staying at home as much as possible. This Executive Order also directs the Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) to issue a corresponding Public Health Order.

CDPHE is expected to release additional guidance on houses of worship, outdoor recreation, personal recreation, and updates to the child care and personal services guidance. Playgrounds and swimming pools can open at limited capacity and the Governor encourages people to have safe fun outdoors away from others.
