



# STAGE 1 FIRE RESTRICTIONS

EFFECTIVE JULY 6, 2020 | Resolution Number 2020-R-014

Fire restrictions are in effect for all public and private property in unincorporated Delta County except for:

- The Grand Mesa, Uncompahgre or Gunnison National Forests or Bureau of Land Management Land,
- Colorado State Parks at the Sweitzer Lake and Crawford State Park
- Property within municipalities that have not adopted their own fire restrictions.

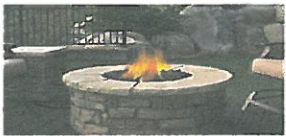


## ALLOWED UNDER STAGE I:



Fires in permanent fire pits, rings or BBQ grills at:

- Private Residences
- Within developed recreational sites such as campgrounds or picnic areas.



Residential fire features such as chimneas, tiki torches and gas fire pits when supervised by a responsible adult.



Liquid or gas fueled stoves, lanterns and heating devices with a controlled flame.



Use of a chainsaw with a USDA/SAE approved spark arrestor and a chemical pressurized fire extinguisher of at least 8 ounces and one large shovel.

Fire extinguisher must be kept with the operator at all times.

Responsible target practice is allowed as is Welding, if conducted in a safe manner in an area void of combustibile material.



## NOT ALLOWED UNDER STAGE I:



### FIREWORKS

The personal use of ALL fireworks is prohibited.



### OPEN FIRES to include:

Bon Fires or camp fires not within a permanent fire grate in a developed campground, park, residence or picnic area.



### SMOKING EXCEPT:

Inside a vehicle or in a designated smoking are that is barren of combustibile material for at least 6 feet around where you are standing.



### AGRICULTURAL BURNING\*

The burning of fence rows, fields, ditches, debris or brush is prohibited.

\*Except with a permit issued by the Sheriff's Office after inspection of area and material to be burned. Call 874-2000 to request.



### EXPLODING TARGETS AND TRACER ROUNDS

The use of exploding shooting targets or tracer ammunition is prohibited under Stage I restrictions.
